The BBTS bursary is awarded to enable individuals working at junior staff grades in transfusion medicine to experience the BBTS Annual Conference and for PhD students and newly qualified staff to present their research work at the meeting.

ELIGIBILITY: Junior healthcare and laboratory staff, newly appointed transfusion practitioners, junior nursing and training medical grades. Successful applicants must already be, or must become, a member of the Society for 2017/18.

The number of bursaries will vary annually according to available budget. The selection procedure will be carried out by the Scientific Meeting Administration Committee.

The total value of each bursary is a complimentary place at the BBTS Annual Conference including up to 3 nights accommodation, all meals, attendance at the Gala dinner and a maximum of £100 towards travel costs to be claimed retrospectively.

The BBTS Annual Conference 2017 will take place in Glasgow, 13th - 15th September 2017.

Applications will not be processed without the following documentation:

1. Completed application form including supporting statements from applicant and their employer
2. A list a national meetings the applicant has attended over the last 3 years
