




Testing undertaken by more than one technique or on more than one analyser

Are the results that you submit ever influenced by the results other laboratories have obtained?






Within your own network

If there is sufficient material, do you use the leftovers to undertake further testing after the results have been submitted?




Leftover material is used for IQC of other techniques or analysers







